E3 Works is a program designed to assist individuals ages 14 to 24 who have experienced barriers in life that have made it difficult to reach their education and career goals. To meet the needs of our participants, we offer a wide range of services directly or through community partners.

Eligibility Criteria for Participants:

- Basic skills deficiency
- English Language Learners
- Justice-involved history
- Homeless or runaway

- Currently in or aged out of Foster Care
- Pregnant or parenting
- Disability
- Dropped out or not attending high school

Program Elements Available:

- 1. Tutoring, study skills, and literacy development
- 2. Alternative school services and GED/HSED prep
- 3. Paid and unpaid work experiences
- 4. Occupational skills training
- 5. Integrated education and workplace training
- 6. Leadership development opportunities
- 7. Supportive services (transportation, clothing, equipment, housing, training, etc.)
- 8. Adult mentoring
- 9. Comprehensive guidance and counseling
- 10. Financial literacy education
- 11. Entrepreneurial skills training
- 12. Career awareness, exploration, and counseling
- 13. Postsecondary prep and transition activities
- 14. Follow-up services

ELEVATE to a permanent entry-level position or enroll in training necessary for desired employment
