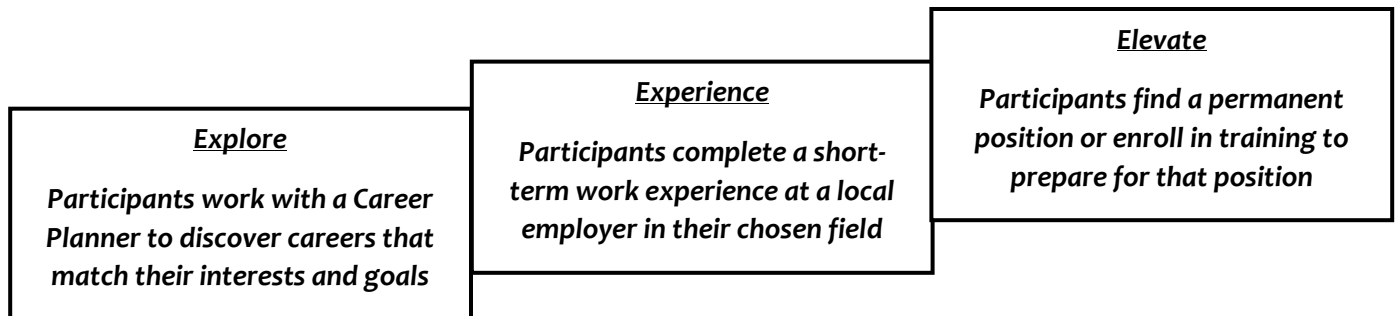




**We need employers like you to join us in providing valuable work experiences

E3 Works is a program designed to assist individuals ages 14 to 24 who have experienced life barriers reach their career goals. We provide a variety of services for our participants to ensure they are trained and prepared for work. E3 Works partners with employers to match our participants with appropriate industries and positions.



E3 Works covers costs including:

- Wages
- Background checks
- Worker compensation insurance
- Equipment, clothing, tools necessary for employment
- Transportation

Employer responsibilities for a work experience agreement:

- Establish work hours and schedule
- Length and type of experience (includes OJT, internship, and job shadowing)
- Assign duties and tasks
- Skills to be learned during experience
- Evaluation of participant performance
- Provide participant timesheet information

Advantages of becoming an employer host site:

- Low cost for recruiting new employees
- Interview with participant to determine fit for position
- Ability to train to meet business needs and goals
- Evaluate participant for regular employment based on actual job performance
- Establishing a pipeline to bring new, qualified workers to your site
- Marketing of business on E3 Works materials distributed online and across eight counties in Western Wisconsin
